Subject: Individual Honors

When an individual honor is attempted by the Pathfinder outside of the club setting and all activities must be supervised by the parent.

The parent will request honor requirements from assigned group leader.

The following individual honor guidelines will be adhered by all Pathfinders, Parents, and Staff:

- Must be an active Pathfinder in the club at time of honor completion.
- The Pathfinder's class leader needs to be notified of any honors that are being worked on before they are submitted.
- All honor work is to be submitted in the Pathfinder's handwriting and that the Pathfinder should be able to demonstrate a basic knowledge and competency of the subject matter.
- All questions need to be written and answered specifically. It is not acceptable to
 photocopy and submit a packet of information that possibly has the answers included in
 it.
- All required activities need to be thoroughly documented. Pictures and/or products need to be submitted with paperwork. Field trips need pictures of the trip and/or tickets, ect.
- Any incomplete work will be returned for completion without credit being given until it is finished.

Note: Failure to follow any of one of these requirements may prevent the Pathfinder from receiving credit for honor completion.
